The way teams will be selected for Australs and Worlds is substantially different the method used for Easters.

1. The externals selector(s) will prepare a ranked list of a pool of debaters to attend based on their performance in a trial debate.
2. This list will be given to the Registrations Officer and be circulated around members of the executive who aren't trialling for acceptance.
3. A non-ranked list will be circulated among those who trialled to inform them as to whether or not they have been selected and if so, from which pool they may select teammates.
4. The person ranked first will be notified by the Registrations Officer, and they are entitled to pick any teammates that are in the pool of selected debaters. They must contact each individual person they choose and obtain consent from them to be on their team. They will then contact the Registrations Officer and confirm who is on their team.
5. After a team is established, the next highest ranked person who is not currently in a team will be contacted and the process outlined in (4) will be continue until the $n-1^{\text {th }}$ team is formed. Remaining individuals will be placed in the $\mathrm{n}^{\text {th }}$ team.
6. This team list then must be approved by the executive. The executive reserves the right to alter teams, or send them back for re-selection if, for example, AA is not met.
7. The team list will be then circulated among those who were selected.
